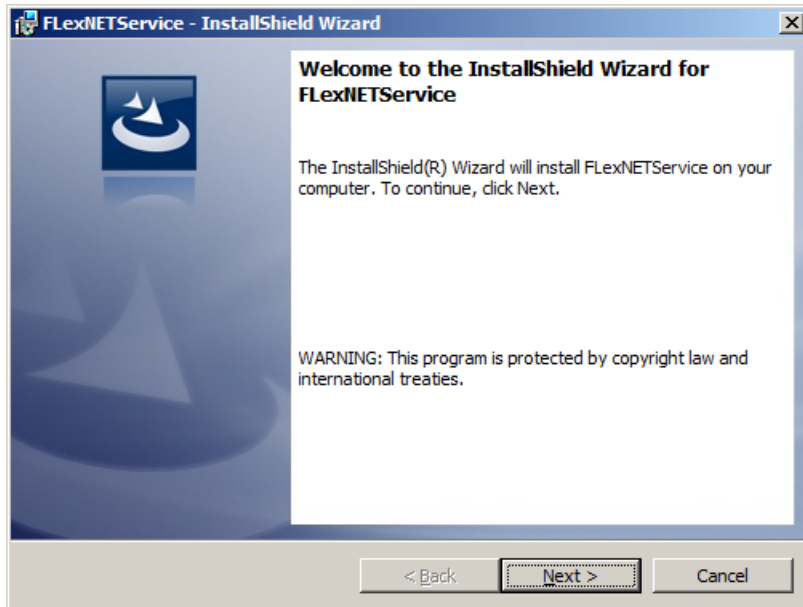
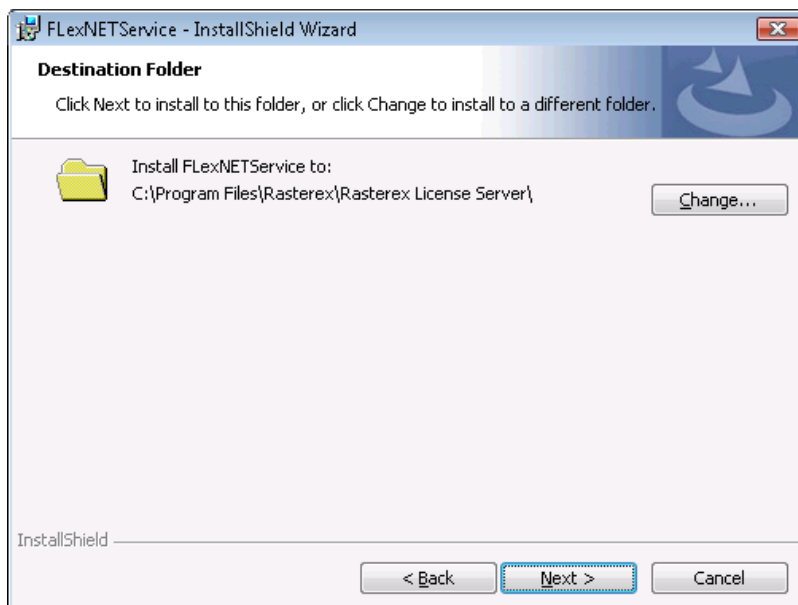


How to install FlexNET service

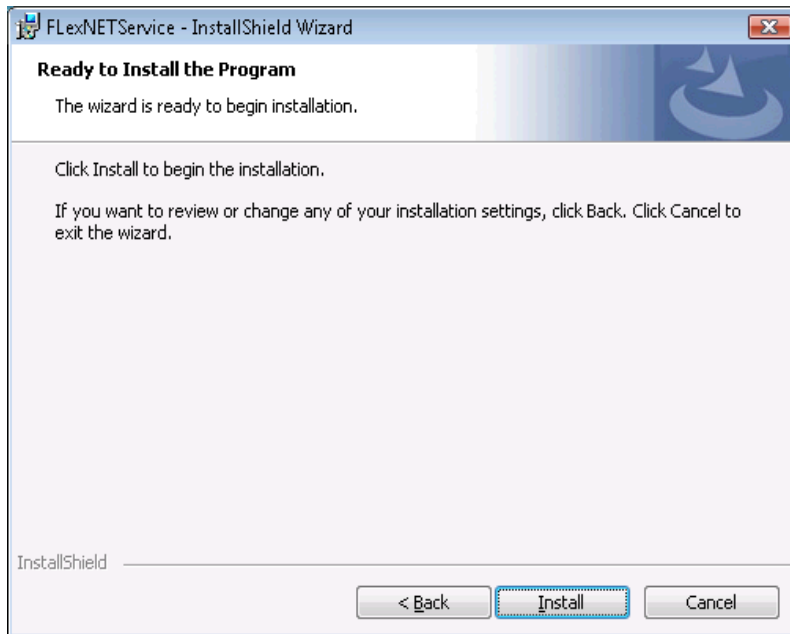
Start FLeXNETService.msi. The following dialog will appear.
Click **Next** to continue the installation.



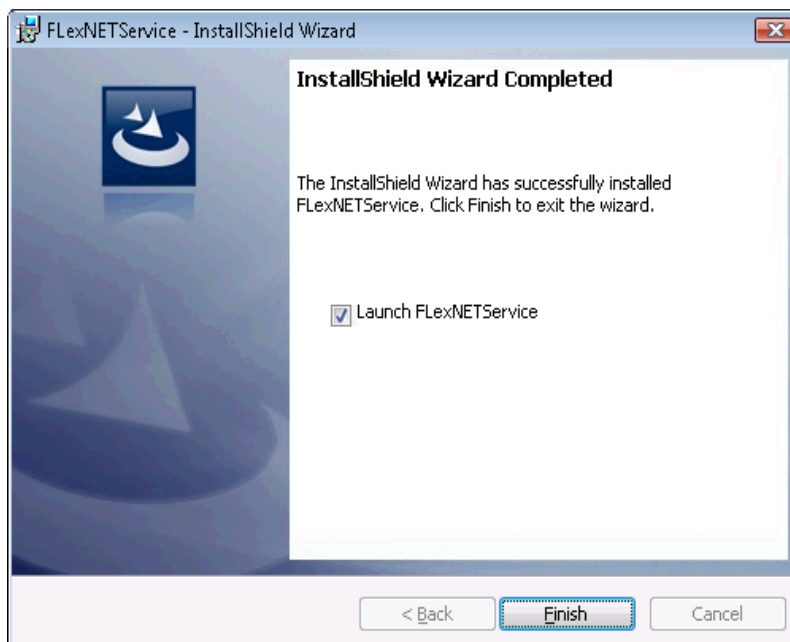
If you want to install the license server to another destination than the default folder, click "Change" otherwise click "Next".



Click Next to begin the installation



The Installation is finished. The installation should open the FlexNET service installation folder and you can choose to start LMTOOLS when the installation is complete by leaving the "Launch FlexNET Service" checkbox checked.



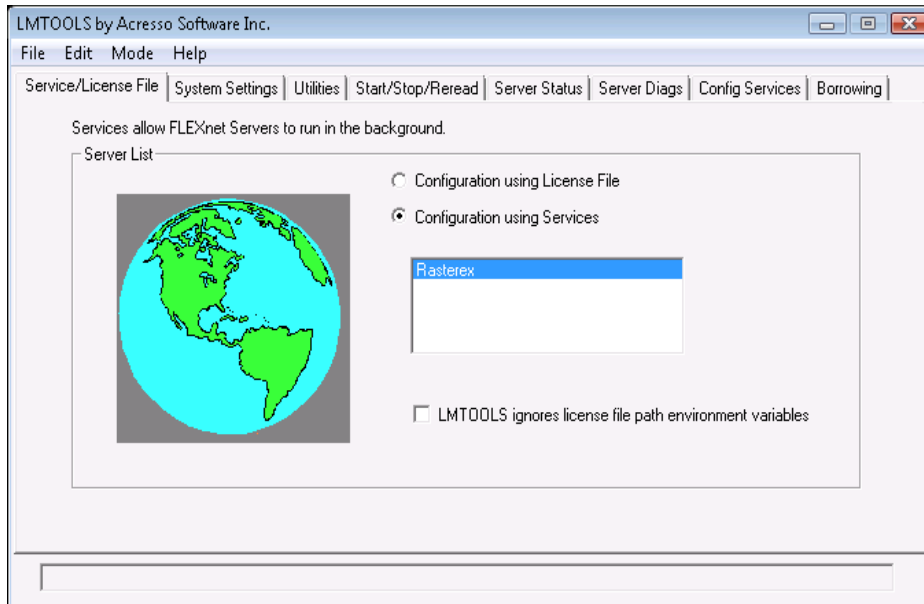
If you have received your license file, you can now copy the file to the installation folder. If you do not have a license file, contact your dealer/distributor. You can continue the FlexNET service setup after receiving a license file.



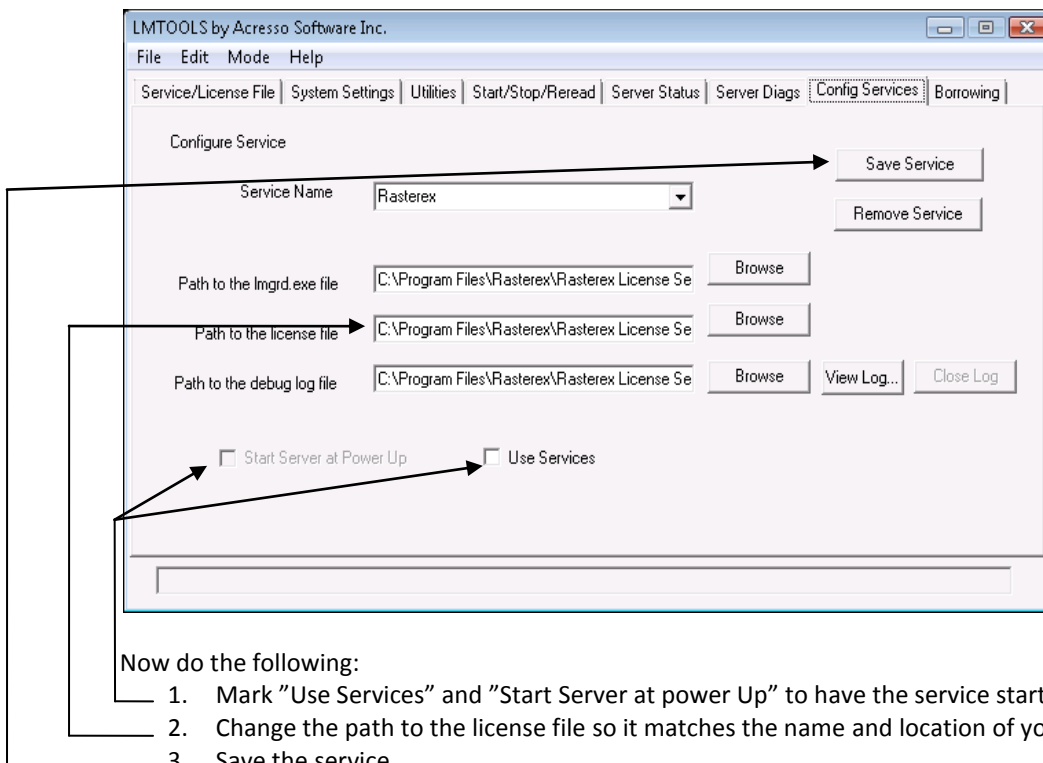
If you started LMTTOOLS after the installation was complete you should see the window below. Otherwise you will find it under "Start", "Programs", "Rasterex", " FLEXNETService".

You will now configure the server.

We start with the Information under the "Service/License File" tab. Select Configuration using Services. Then select the tab "Config Services".



You will see the following dialog:

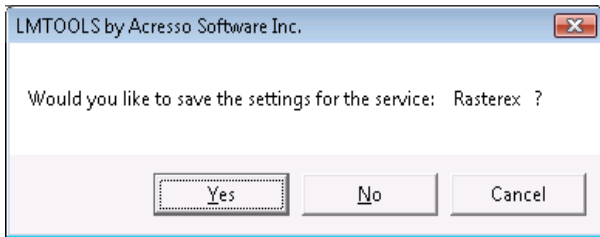


Now do the following:

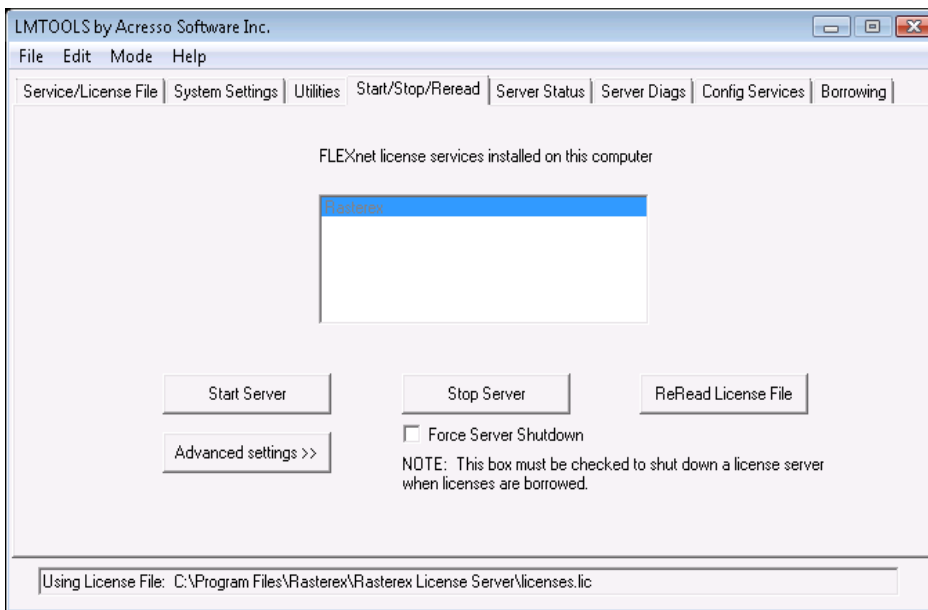
1. Mark "Use Services" and "Start Server at power Up" to have the service start automatically.
2. Change the path to the license file so it matches the name and location of your license file.
3. Save the service.



If you see a question like this, answer "Yes".



To start the service immediately, either reboot the computer or select the "Start/Stop/Reread" tab to manually start the service by clicking on the "Start Server" button.
